

Identify Sentence Pattern

Sentence pattern is the combination of subject, verb, direct object, indirect object, complement, & adjunct, etc.

What is **Subject**?

Subject is about who (or) what? Mainly, it covers the noun and pronoun like name of place, things, etc.

What is **Verb**?

Verb means action or work done by the subject.

What is **Direct object**?

DO, usually answers the question 'what' (or) whom, etc.

IO is also same category which answers to the question.

What is **complement**?

Complement is helpful in completing the sentence (or) gives absolute meaning to the sentence.

What is **Adjunct**?

Adjunct always gives extra added information to the sentence.
